UNIFORM:

Uniforms are available in the school.

Mondays: Grey and white shirt with black pairs of shoes.

Tuesdays: Grey and peach shirt with black pair of shoes.

Wednesdays: Sports wear with white sneakers.

Thursdays: Grey and peach shirt with black pair shoes.

Fridays: Sports wear with white sneakers.

· Shoes should be black closed toe and low heel.

Hair: Hair must be well kept and should not be extreme. No coloured attachment, no wig, no beads, low cuts for boys.

Girls should wear simple stud earrings.



School Year: The school enjoys an eventful school calendar. Each calendar year/ session consists of three terms of not less than twelve (12) weeks each, mid-term breaks are observed in line with the state academic calendar.

Information: Information about up-coming events are found in the school 's Website, school newsletters, children's communication book, school calendar, notice board or can be communicated through SMS/ text message, social media (WhatsApp and Facebook).



DAILY ROUTINE

- **1. Resumption:** The school gate opens at 7:00 am. Parents are advised to ensure that their children/wards are brought to school before 7:40am.
- 2. Assembly: School assembly which is an important part of school life, starts at 7:45am on Mondays (General Assembly), Tuesdays (Circle Time), Wednesdays (Aerobics and Exercises), Thursdays (General Assembly) and Fridays (Moral Instructions).
- **3. Lessons:** All classes start at 8:15am and end at 2:30pm for the Preschool (Nursery) and 3:30pm for the Basic.
- Parents are expected to pick up their children/wards from school before 4:00pm.
 - Fridays: school closes at 2:00pm for both Nursery and Primary.
- \cdot All pupils should leave the school premises before 3:00pm.
- 4. Parents are encouraged to feed their children with natural food and snacks and reduce the intake of sugar-laced food and snacks.
- 5. Club Activities: these include Press, Debate, Drama, JET clubs.
- **6. Competitions:** Our pupils shall be exposed to both National and International Competitions.
- 7. **Intervention Programmes**: Clinics are available for pupils who need extra attention in the following areas Mathematics, Reading and Writing.

8. Programmes/ Events: These shall include

- **Open House** the school opens her gate to the public to come and have a view of what the school has and does. This is done once in a while.
- **Breakfast meeting** Parents are given the opportunity to get acquainted with the expectations of their children/ wards in a particular class. This takes place once in a session.
- Parents-teachers Conference (PTC) This is a meeting between the teacher, parents of the child and the child to discuss their academic progress. This is done termly.
- **Parents-Teachers' Forum (PTF)** This is a meeting of parents, teachers and the school to assess the school progress and discuss the way forward. This is held termly.

United Nation Days - Some UN days shall be observed/ celebrated to expose the pupils to global education.

- **Birthday**: Any parent who wishes to celebrate the child's/ ward's birthday in the school is requested to give 48 hours' notice. Items to be made available include:
- Birthday cake
- Biscuits, sweets, etc.
- Popular drinks for children.
- Gifts
- Party bag
- Any other items.

All these are to be submitted at the school admin office while bringing the child to school on the day of the celebration. The school takes care of the sharing of the items to the classmates of the celebrants. The school coordinates the birthday celebration which last for few minutes as follows: Monday - Thursday: 2:00pm - 2:30pm. Friday: 12:00pm - 12:30pm

Other events shall include Cultural day, Inter-house Sports, Christmas/ End of the year Party, Graduation, Beauty Pageant, Career Day, Snow Day, Cartoon



10. SAFETY: children should be brought to school and picked by an adult. Parents are to present the pick-up card issued by the school before the child will be released. If you will not be able to come for your child, please let the school know who will be coming in your place and let the person come with the pick-up card. WE WILL NOT RELEASE YOUR CHILD TO ANOTHER ADULT UNLESS YOU NOTIFY AND PERMITTED US.





11. IMMUNIZATION:

Immunization is administered to a child if his/ her parent gives a written consent.

11. MEDICINES IN THE SCHOOL: We need to know about any particular need before your child is registered with the school or when a child first develops a medical need. Parents should tell us about the medicines that their child needs to take. All medicines must be brought to the school office by the child's parent where a consent form will be signed. No child should bring medicines themselves.





12. **SECURITY:** Please sign the attendance book as soon as your child enters the school. And sign out when you pick him/her after school.

13. COMPLAINTS: If you are unhappy with any aspect of the school services, you are encouraged to report to the school management through the Communication book. You are free to come to the school for ono-onone discussion with the school management too.



Note: Parents are encouraged to communicate with the school through the school official line. Calls to teachers during school hours are prohibited.
